## TTXGP - Racing Green, The Story Behind the TTXGP

This talk will explain how TTXGP has taken the Isle of Man TT Motorcycle race into its second century by staging the world's first zero emission motorcycle race as part of the June 2009 TT Race series.

The talk explains how the race, by imposing stringent 'zero emission' rules on the bikes, aims to promote the acceptance and commercial reality of zero emission vehicles for everyday use. Its intention is also to inspire a new generation of engineers to step up and address the challenges and problems of the 21st Century.

There will be footage of the bikes in action, and photographs of the entries, with plenty of discussion of the technologies deployed.
